Ms. Angeli played for teams across multiple women's soccer leagues in the US: Boston Breakers (WPS), Washington Spirit, and Western New York Flash (NWSL). She was named Best IX in WPS in 2010 and led all rookies in goals that season. Ms. Angeli was a member of the 2006 U20 World Cup Women's national team and the 2011 USWNT pool. In 2023, she joined CBS Sports as a match analyst for NWSL games, appearing on CBS Sports Network and Paramount+. Ms. Angeli continues to elevate the game as an analyst for Major League Soccer and international broadcasts. She is also known for volunteering with the Colorado Rapids Unified teams.
